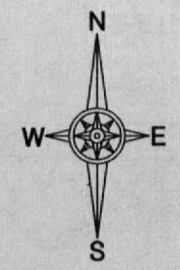
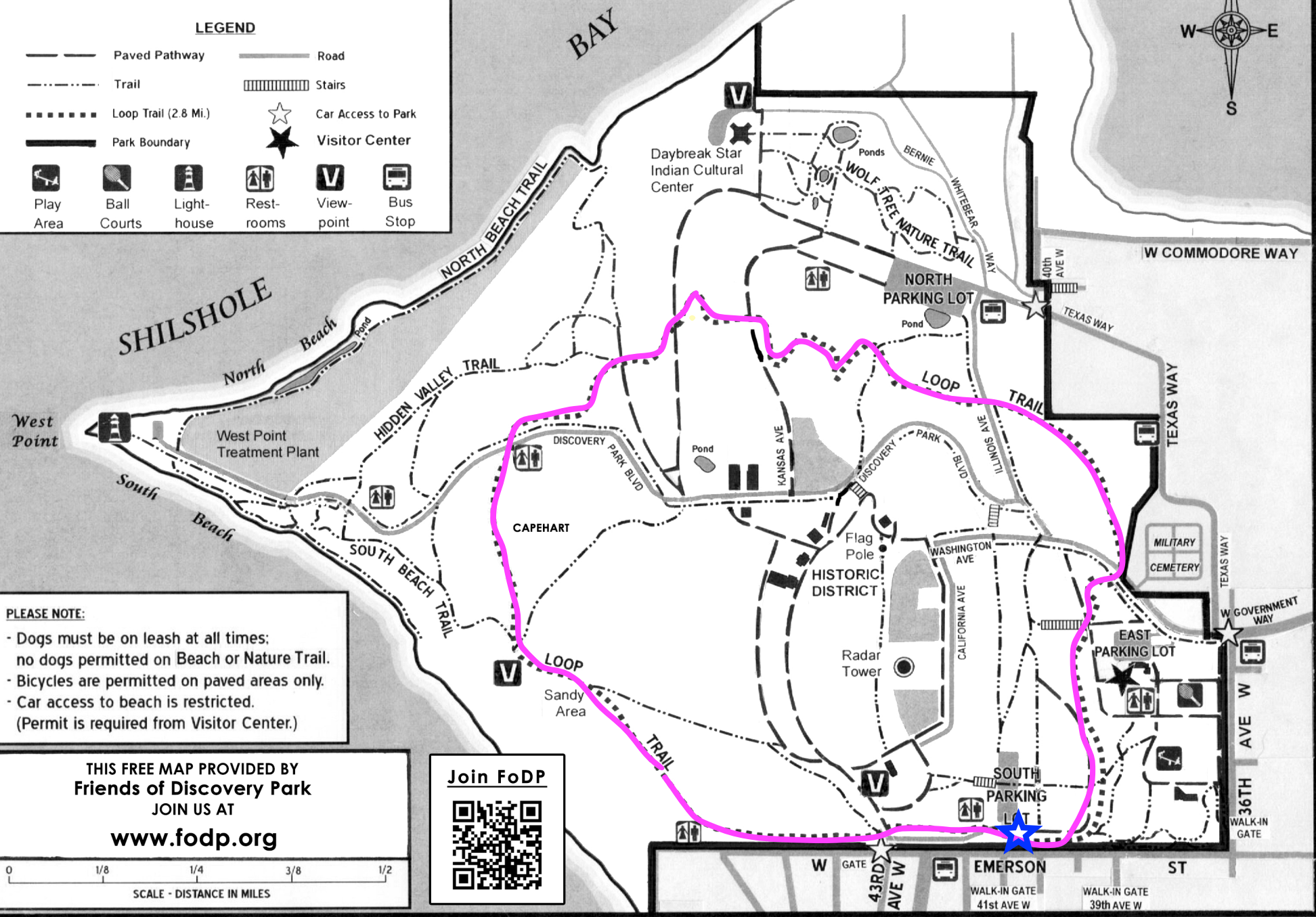


WAY-FINDING MAP OF DISCOVERY PARK
